

AMICI STRING PROGRAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION 2025-2026

Welcome to the Amici String Program! We are now accepting registrations for the 2025-2026 year.

We offer technique/ masterclasses and chamber music to string students. This year, chamber music will be from 4:30-5:30pm or 6:30-7:30pm on Monday evenings. Technique/ Masterclasses will be from 5:30-6:30 pm on Monday evenings.

All classes are held at Bethany Chapel of Calgary, 3333 Richardson Way SW (across from Mount Royal University). Classes are from September 29, 2025 to April 20, 2026.

Schedule

4:30 – 5:30 pm Chamber music

5:30 – 6:30 pm Technique/Masterclasses

6:30 - 7:30 pm Chamber music

Placement in classes will be at the discretion of the Artistic Director in consultation with the student's private teacher. After the final registration deadline on September 1st, you will be notified of your class times. Please be prepared to attend Amici during any two consecutive hours between 4:30 and 7:30pm on Monday nights. This allows for correct placement in masterclass and chamber music.

Please note any time restrictions or schedule conflicts that are completely unavoidable on the registration form. Please understand that time constraints may make chamber music placement limited or impossible. No accommodation for student schedules will be considered after September 1st, 2025.

Entry level minimum requirements

Repertoire level of approximately RCM Grade 6; knowledge of at least one 3-octave scale; and well-established skills in shifting and vibrato.

Recitals

We host monthly Sunday recitals which are open to all Amici students at Bethany Chapel (3333 Richardson Road SW). The first recital for the 2025-2026 season will take place in October. Any non-Amici student may take part if they are playing at an RCM Grade 6 level and above. Recital registration takes place a week prior to each recital.

Accompanist Subsidy - Technique/Masterclass

Registration in Masterclass includes 4 hours of rehearsal time with an Amici accompanist.

Annual Volunteer Bond

To maintain affordable registration fees and ensure the smooth operation of our program, we rely on each family to volunteer throughout the calendar year (from October 1st to September 30th). Volunteer opportunities include working at casinos, helping with recital receptions, supporting endofyear events, aiding with summer camp lunches, assisting with fundraising initiatives, serving on the Amici Board, and other possible tasks. Volunteer requests are communicated via email on a first-come, first-served basis.

The Amici Strings Program requires one \$250 volunteer bond cheque from each family. Registration in the Amici Program assumes a commitment to fulfil volunteer requirements for the full calendar year (October 1st - September 30th).

A list of volunteer hours is maintained. Volunteer bond cheques will be destroyed after September 30th, 2026 for those fulfilling this requirement. Families that choose not to fulfill their volunteer commitment will have their cheques deposited as a non-volunteer buyout.

All families are encouraged to volunteer at various Amici-related events throughout the year.

Automatic deposit is set up, no password is needed. Please include the e-transfer confirmation number on the registration form. The name of the program being registered for, and student's name(s) should be noted in the e-transfer message section.

<u>Payment of fees via cheque:</u> For your convenience, cheques for registration fee payment may either be for the full amount postdated September 1st, 2025 *or* cheques may be divided evenly in three payments postdated September 1st, 2025, November 1st, 2025, and February 1st, 2026. Please make cheques payable to **Amici String Program Association.** A bank service charge will be added to any NSF cheques returned to Amici.

<u>Volunteer bond cheques</u> may be either mailed (please see address below) or hand delivered on the first day of classes. Please make cheques payable to **Amici String Program Association.** Postdate the cheques to September 30th, **2026.**

REFUND POLICY

In recognition of the impact on other participants of the program, a penalty for withdrawal from the program after the registration deadline of September 1st, 2025 will be in effect:

- 1. Withdrawals from Amici String Program before September 1st will receive a full refund
- 2. Withdrawals from September 2nd 15th will be subject to a 50% penalty
- 3. After September 15th, no refund will be provided

Reimbursement of program fees after September 15th with special circumstances may be considered at the discretion of the Board.
